## **Internship opportunities in CEEweb for Biodiversity**

Internships with CEEweb for Biodiversity are unpaid, but full of new experiences. We encourage to apply to Erasmus+ programme to support your stay in Budapest with us.

CEEweb for Biodiversity was founded in 1994 (under the name of Central and East European Working Group for the Enhancement of Biodiversity). One primary aim of the organization is to help the implementation of international tasks under the Convention on Biological Diversity. Presently CEEweb is the only network in operation which has been set up and run by nature conservation NGOs in Central and Eastern Europe.

The mission of CEEweb for Biodiversity is the conservation of biodiversity through the promotion of sustainable development. CEEweb works through advocacy, influencing decision making, common projects, capacity building, networking and awareness raising. It targets its members, local, national and international decision makers, NGOs and NGO networks, companies and the scientific community.

You are welcome to apply all year round, however we also have calls for specific interns when we need help in specific field.

### **Areas of work in 2017**

1. Natura 2000
  - a. Raising awareness on the socio-economic benefits of the Nature Directives,
  - b. Help to organize a conference on socio-economic benefits of Natura 2000 in Brussels,
  - c. Gathering best practices of management of the sites,
  - d. Consultation of complaints from Member States to the European Commission,
  
2. Green Infrastructure and Ecosystem Services
  - a. Raising awareness on the socio-economic benefits of the Biodiversity Strategy Target 2 elements and the Natural Water Retention Measures showing contribution to jobs and growth
  - b. Building and promoting the building of European project partnerships among cities, municipalities, sectors, business and research institutes to engage in joint activities and submit relevant project proposals under EU, national and private funding streams for biodiversity and for fighting climate,
  - c. Extending support of EU decision makers and stakeholders to biodiversity policies and their implementation,
  - d. Increasing implementation of ecosystem services approach and Green Infrastructure Strategy and their uptake by sartorial policies,
  - e. Integrating EU and national health, water, spatial planning and agriculture policies as

well as initiatives include and refer to Green Infrastructure and Ecosystem Services and employ them during implementation,

- f. Preparation for the review of Water Framework Directive, policy analysis, advocacy campaign.
- g. Help to prepare the European Urban Green Infrastructure Conference 29-30th November 2017, which brings together leaders in urban green infrastructure to share nature-based solutions for resilient 21st century cities. Support the logistics, fundraising, communication and programme development and participate in the event.

### 3. Agriculture

- a. Working out a new indicator system for agriculture incorporating social and economic considerations while supporting a result-based agriculture,
- b. Campaigning for public money for public goods including a sustainable EU budget and a result based Common Agriculture Policy (CAP) considering climate, social and environmental aspects,
- c. Advocacy for the review of the CAP delivering public goods and based on actual results with the focus on climate, social and biodiversity aspects with an adequate indicator system is in place,

### 4. EU budget

- a. Elaborating on new instruments on sustainability proofing and mainstreaming the integration of biodiversity and climate change into EU sartorial funding through our MFF activities,
- b. Mobilizing funding for biodiversity and for fighting climate change on national and EU levels through dedicated communication, awareness raising and capacity building activities,
- c. Mobilizing EU and private sources funding climate change mitigation, green infrastructure and mapping and assessing ecosystem services projects,
- d. Increasing public attention on natural capital, EU budget, CAP along with increased will in participation of forming these processes.

### 5. Sustainable tourism and integrated transport planning in the Carpathians (Hungarian speaking intern preferred)
